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e-IEP PRO Highlights from 2022 and Exciting Projections for the e-IEP PRO in 2023

Some highlights for the e-IEP PRO from 2022 include:

- **Sustained State-wide Adoption** - In 2022, a significant number of Local Education Agencies (LEAs) in Arizona made the switch to the e-IEP PRO. Currently, over 552 Arizona LEAs are using the e-IEP PRO that are comprised as follows: (A) 171 Arizona public school districts (~70% of Arizona public school districts), (B) 371 Arizona charter and private schools (~60% of Arizona charter schools and (C) 10 State and local agencies.
- **98% Retention** - In 2022, thanks to the loyalty and dedication of our customers, the e-IEP PRO maintained its exceptional retention rate. In the 22 years that the e-IEP PRO has been

provided in Arizona, the e-IEP PRO has experienced a 98% retention rate of all LEAs sold. Arizona LEAs continue to experience that promises or claims of comparable special education management products and services do not match the strong and consistent services offered by the e-IEP PRO and its support team.

- **Added New Features and Capabilities** - Continuing the trend of adding more value to its products and services, Version 22.0 of the e-IEP PRO, incorporates a unique number of new and exciting enhancements.
- **Over 24,000 Student Record Transfers Completed** - In the 2021-22 school year, over 24,000

electronic student record transfer requests were processed by the e-IEP PRO moving student data amongst districts, charter schools, and state agencies within Arizona. For the 2022-23 school year, e-IEP PRO is on pace to complete over 25,000 electronic student transfer requests.

- **Celebrating 22 Years** - e-IEP PRO enters its 22nd year of service in Arizona in 2023. We have greatly enjoyed our work in Arizona over the last 22 years and we are looking forward to many more years of continued dedicated and successful service.

Interactive e-Training Plus Feature Added to the e-Training Module

An exciting new interactive online training feature has been added to the e-IEP PRO called e-Training Plus. The new e-Training Plus feature is included within the e-Training module. The initial release of this feature provides two video-based interactive curriculums that include (1) a comprehensive in-service training session on how to use the e-IEP PRO and (2) an e-IEP PRO Boot Camp session designed for e-IEP PRO Administrators. Both curriculums provide comprehensive video-based segments with interactive quizzes and provide a professional development certificate upon completion of the curriculum.

The first training curriculum is available to all users and is titled “New Staff Training”. This is a complete 2.5 hour recorded training that covers all areas and modules of the e-IEP PRO that includes Basic Navigation and a thorough review of the Student Profiles, Conference Summaries,

Referrals, Meeting Notices, Prior Written Notices, Supporting Documentation, Evaluation/MET, IEP Designer, Reference Area, Miscellaneous Forms, Reporting, and the e-Training module. This curriculum contains 20 video segments and 13 quizzes/assessments including a final exam.

The second training curriculum is available to Primary System Administrator (PSA) users and is titled “PSA Boot Camp”. This is an intensive training session held via Zoom in September 2021. This training curriculum is designed to train district e-IEP PRO PSA users to better utilize and/or support end-users in the use of all e-IEP PRO Software Modules that include: (a) Student Profiles, (b) Conference Summaries, (c) Referral, (d) Meeting Notice, (e) Prior Written Notice, (f) Supporting Documentation, (g) MET Report Writing, (h) IEP Report Writing, (i) Compliance Reporting and (j) Ad-Hoc Reporting. This on-line

training video runs for approximately 2 hours and contains 12 video segments and 11 quizzes/assessments including a final exam.

For both curriculums, after completion of all video segments and assessments, the user then can download a certificate of completion from the My Certificates area. The certificate will contain the date of completion, the user name and the full name of the user.

This new feature can be accessed by selecting the “e-Training” in the top right of the e-IEP PRO software screen and then selecting the “e-Training Plus” option from the e-Training Module menu.

Additional curriculum will be developed and added to this new feature in the near future.

The e-MTSS PRO software, developed by MediaNet Solutions, is a comprehensive MTSS student management system that tightly integrates all MTSS student data and corresponding documents into one comprehensive system.
